#### **Applications**

In this application, you will be working on the first page of the website - an informative page.

During this exercise, you are only allowed to use **Notepad**. The use of any other type of text editor such as Notepad++ or for web development tools such as Dreamweaver or Expression Web will result in immediate disqualification from this event.

A screen capture of the expected end result is included for your inspection and to be used as a guide for completing this exercise.

When complete, print all code generated for this exercise (HTML and Style Sheet). Also print a screen capture of your finished work as it appears in the web browser so that it may be used for grading purposes.

Submit all printed pages, along with your copy of this test, and your answer form to your proctor.

Your task is to regenerate the web page shown in the screen capture provided in this packet, using HTML 5, CSS, and the parameters specified below.

- 1. Overall Specifications
  - a. The document must be valid HTML5
  - b. The documents must be styled with an external cascading style sheet
    - i. ALL styles *must* be done with the style sheet. Using tags or style attributes within tags is **PROHIBITED**
  - c. The document *must not* use tables for any sort of layout or positioning.
- 2. General Pages Specifications
  - a. Title should have Your constant number Fundamentals of Web Design
  - b. Before the closing head tag, create a comment in the CSS that says the following: "Formatting for the Home page for Russo's Pizzeria"
  - c. Background color is rgb (128, 0, 0)
  - d. Text Color #000000
  - e. The width of the page body needs to be 1024 pixels
  - f. The default font for page body needs to be 'Times New Roman" with a fall back on "times" and another fall back on "serif"
  - g. Create a container using an ID that will hold all the information on the page. Use the following properties for the style on the page:
    - i. background color: #FFFFFF
    - ii. Top Margin: 20 pixels
    - iii. Right Margin: 100 pixels
    - iv. Bottom Margin: 20 pixels
    - v. Left Margin: 100 pixels
    - vi. Padding: 25 pixels
